### **Formal Business**

# 1. Apologies for Absence

No apologies for absence were received.

# **Items for Discussion and Decision**

- Feedback on the Knowle speed camera is disappointing which means that B/S PC continue to do manual counts.
- Discussion regarding cause of leak in high street it was conjectured that it may be caused by heavy vehicles going through the village.
- Work on Church Hill causes concern re width of tarmac refer to Claire Wright.
- Junction at the bottom of Bell Street continues to give concern and a member of the public is taking this up with parliament. He has promised to keep us posted.
- It was suggested by a member of the public that the planting in the village could be improved. An offer was made to research an RHS award, speak to the gardening club and report back to us.

# 6. Chairman's Business

The Chairman gave a report as follows:-

Parishes Together meeting:- Fund based on the basis of number on the electoral role, therefore if Parishes work together then more money can be gained. Landing strip for air ambulance is a hot topic.

Fire brigade have powers to stop traffic etc if they need to access a building.

Plant pots on green:- Offer of donation from a resident to refurbish plant pots. Offer from Melaine Martin to obtain discount on plants.
